4th/5th/6th GRADE CO-ED VOLLEYBALL INFORMATION SHEET

This will be a co-ed team consisting of 5th and 6th grade students. However, 4th grade students are eligible to play should there not be enough students registered from 5th/6th. If a 4th grade student is interested in playing, please submit the required registration forms and your student will be considered for placement on the team. Priority goes to the 5th and 6th grade students.

Practices: Start Tuesday, August 21st, and will be held every Tuesday and Thursday from 4:30-5:30 on the basketball court at the school until the end of the season (approximately the end of October)

Practices are closed practice. Please drop off 5 minutes prior to start of practice and pick up on time at 5:30. Please bring a water bottle to practice.

Games: Games will be on Tuesday evenings (either 5:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m.) and Saturdays (between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.) in September and October. The game schedule will be provided as soon as it is available. Transportation to and from practice and games is the parent's responsibility

UNIFORM: Game shirt will be provided to the team.

Players will provide the following items for games:

- 1) Black soffe shorts or black athletic shorts
- 2) Court sneakers
- 3) Black socks
- 4) Knee pads

COST & REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

Registration paperwork is due to the school office no later than end of the business day on **Friday, August 17, 2018** and can be turned in prior to that date. The team positions will be filled using a lottery system with a maximum of 12 players on the team and priority consideration given to 5th and 6th grade students. The cost is \$90.00 which is due with registration. Registration will NOT BE ACCEPTED without payment. Check made payable to Pineapple Cove Classical Academy.

PLEASE NOTE:

This team may be a co-ed, all girls, or all boys team. The league has an "A" Division and a "B" Division. The team will be placed according to the number of 5th graders versus 6th graders. Therefore, please be aware 5th or 4th grade students may be playing against an all 6th grade team.

PLAYER REQUIREMENT:

Eligibility Requirements: All players MUST not have any major disciplinary issues during the season (which includes pre-season conditioning) until the last scheduled game in order to be eligible to play on the team. Should any major disciplinary issues arise, the player may be suspended from play and practice for a period of time which is at the discretion of administration.
