4th/5th/6th GRADE BOYS & GIRLS BASKETBALL INFORMATION SHEET

There will be a boys team and girls team consisting of 5th and 6th grade students. However, 4th grade students are eligible to play should there not be enough students registered from 5th/6th. If a 4th grade student is interested in playing, please submit the required registration forms by the registration deadline and your student will be considered for placement on the team. Priority goes to the 5th and 6th grade students.

Practices: Start mid-November, and will be held twice a week from 4:30-5:30 at the school until the end of the season (approximately mid-March). The practice schedule will be made available in the near future.

Practices are closed practice. Please drop off 5 minutes prior to start of practice and pick up on time. Please bring a water bottle to practice.

Games: Schedule to be announced but will start mid-January and finish approximately mid-March. Transportation to and from games is parent's responsibility

UNIFORM: Game shirt will be provided to the team.

Players will provide the following items for games:

- 1) Black athletic shorts
- 2) Court sneakers
- 3) Black socks
- 4) Water bottle

COST & REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

Registration paperwork is due to the school office no later than end of the business day on **Friday, September 28, 2018** and can be turned in prior to that date. The team positions will be filled on a **lottery basis** with a maximum of 10 players on the team and priority consideration given to 5th and 6th grade students. The cost is \$85.00 which is due with registration. Registration will NOT BE ACCEPTED without payment. Payment must be by check made payable to Pineapple Cove Classical Academy.

PLEASE NOTE:

The league has an "A" Division and a "B" Division. The team will be placed according to the number of 5th graders versus 6th graders. Therefore, please be aware 5th or 4th grade students may be playing against an all 6th grade team.

PLAYER REQUIREMENT:

Eligibility Requirements: All players MUST not have any major disciplinary issues during the season (which includes pre-season conditioning) until the last scheduled game in order to be eligible to play on the team. Should any major disciplinary issues arise, the player may be suspended from play and practice for a period of time which is at the discretion of administration.
